## How to Print your Card Design Templates

Open the pdf file, select the paper you want to print your project on, enter 1 for quantity (this is a test print) and press Print. Print at 100%, do not scale image. Every printer is different and may need slight adjustments in color contrast and saturation - always make a test print if you are planning to print multiple copies. The card and envelope are designed so you will need one sheet of 8.5" x 11" paper to print each one.

### *Recommended Inkjet Printer Papers:*

I usually use a bright white matte paper at between 60# and 80# for cards and envelopes. If you don't have a favourite, here are some that I like:

- Red River Premium Matte Plus at 60#
- Epson Ultra Premium Presentation Matte Paper
- HP Bright White, Wausau Premium Cardstock Paper and Paper Source Pure White at 80#

### *After Printing:*

Cut card along the dotted lines with sharp scissors or a paper cutter. You can also use an Exacto-knife and a straight edge steel ruler for better precision when cutting. Fold in half, and use the blunt edge of a regular butter knife or an ivory bone folder to rub along the folded edge to help make the fold flatter.

Cut the envelope along the solid pink line with sharp scissors. It's easy to assemble, just fold in the left and right edges, then the bottom flap up and the top flap down. (The light cream coloured pattern is meant to be the front of the envelope, the solid cream colour, the back). Use the blunt edge of a regular butter knife or an ivory bone folder to rub along the envelope edges to help make the edges flatter. You can use an adhesive (double-stick tape, or a tape dispenser style adhesive, like Tombow Monoadhesive available at Dick Blick and other art supply stores) to stick the side edges of the envelope together or use some pretty stickers to seal the envelope up.
